# CANVAS INVENTORY AND TEXTILE UPDATE



In the USA, we can supply dyed goods as well as greige and artist's canvas. from one warehouse now. Along with many other stocks, our stocks of army Duck are high and ready to ship. The cotton crisis is still an ongoing battle as many companies struggle to receive cotton. Cotton prices are on a steady increase due to the low level of crops growing right now. Since the new crops do not come into the market till November/December the best time to buy is now. In Navegate's weekly freight update, they discusses the supply chain crisis and the overwhelmed ports due to lockdowns being lifted. This will continue to be an issue in the shipping industry as many companies will face back ups.



Cotton prices are expected to reach 1.38 per pound (USD) with a high 1.51 and a low of 1.25 (95% confidence interval) at the end of June.


## **What skills have you developed as an intern at Global Impex?**


## **How has your internship brought you closer to your professional goals?**


