




Update

Supply Chain & Inflation

In the recent updates on the supply chain and shipping, Navegate has reported that the port crisis is beginning to decrease as the supply chain bottleneck is easing off. Port congestion has caused a severe delay in shipping for all different industries. As the ports have begun to come to an agreement and solution due to the new Ocean Shipping Reform Act of 2022. Each industry of the supply chain and shipping industry are connected and have a major effect on each other. With the port congestion decreasing, the pressure can be relieved from the air freight and trucking industries. They have both faced increased demand and shortages recently with the absence of available ships.


As inflation has continued to increase month after month, it seems to be on a non-stop rise with the United States being hit the hardest. But, in the cotton industry with manufacturing staying strong, that is not the case. While inflation has no forecast of slowing down, it does not seem to look to increase in the textile industry in the future. With the increase in inflation, many are talking and worried about a recession. At the moment, in the foreseeable future, there does not look to be an immediate turn to a recession.



Cotton Update

The price per pound of cotton has been declining since the end of June, despite there being no excess supply and potential threats to global harvests. The **USDA** reported lower forecasts for production, exports, and ending stocks in the US for the 2022-23 year due to possible dry weather in Texas. In addition, cotton crops in India are threatened by pink bollworm pests which are attacking sooner due to insufficient rainfall earlier this year. Despite all this, after breaking an 11-year high of \$1.58/lb back in May, the commodity has dropped in price largely due to the onset of a global recession. The demand for non-essential clothing and fabric products has dropped significantly and will continue to be low for a few months as consumers cut back on spending. In the end, the consumer controls the price and discretionary spending has been reduced worldwide. The projected (trend) price line takes into account the pricing for Cotton futures contracts as well. October 2022 futures have dropped down to 99.57 (down 356 points) and December 2022 futures have dropped down to 93.81 (down 293 points). The line shows some upside with the October and December prices being slightly higher than the currently valued futures contracts. This projection is sensitive and likely to change many times as cotton is one of the most unpredictable commodities at times. The price has the potential to rise as we enter the fourth quarter and finish off the year. However, as current global trends and markets stand, the price per pound of cotton should continue to decline slightly through the end of the year. The estimated price per lb will be around \$0.95 in December.
